Resolution 2012-35

To Eliminate Fire Inspector Job Position

WHEREAS, the Deptford Fire District No. 1, as part of its ordinary operating practices, has the authority to establish staffing and employment levels;

WHEREAS, the Fire District has previously had fire inspections performed by an employee in the position of Fire Inspector as well as by other properly-certified employees;

WHEREAS, as a result of a recent retirement, the Fire Inspector job position has been vacant, and fire inspections have been performed since that time by these other employees;

WHEREAS, the Fire District has reviewed its operations since this retirement and has determined that it can fully and satisfactorily complete the necessary fire inspections with these other employees and without having to fill the vacant Fire Inspector position;

WHEREAS, the elimination of the Fire Inspection position will save the Fire District valuable financial resources;

WHEREAS, the elimination of the currently-vacant Fire Inspector job position will not result in any employees being laid off, such that this job elimination without further action or discussion is in compliance with the laws and regulations of the New Jersey Civil Service Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1 in the Township of Deptford, County of Gloucester, at a duly-authorized and noticed public meeting of the Commissioners held on September 5, 2012, that the currently-vacant job position of Fire Inspector is eliminated from the Fire District's current list of job positions.
